

BANCO SOLANAS Y C^A, GUALEGUAY

Agustín Solanas Paredes, entrepreneur born in 1830 in Barcelona, was the founder of the Banco Solanas in Gualeguay, whose creation was authorized by a law of June 19, 1874.

ISSUE OF AUGUST 1, 1874 IN REALES AND PESOS BOLIVIANOS

The half-real note was printed by G. Kraft in Buenos Aires; those of 1, 2, 4 reales and 1 peso, at A. Godel in Montevideo.





TREASURY OF THE PROVINCE OF ENTRE-RÍOS

Printed by Lit. San Martín in Buenos Aires. Dated March¹, 1876.

There are denominations stamped with an oval seal in black, with the provincial crest in the center and highlighting the legend♦ TESORERIA GENERAL ♦ PROVINCIA DE ENTRE RIOS :



This seal was found on denominations of 10, 20 and 50 centavos fuertes.

It is possible that it can be found on other values,
or that these same banknotes also exist without this seal, which remains to be confirmed.

The notes were payable in gold or other legal tender.





CREDITO TERRITORIAL

Printed by Lit. San Martín in Buenos Aires. Dated June 1877.

This is not paper money per se, but rather a bearer security that can be used when paying a kind of property tax. They had an interest of 6% per annum. The titles are stamped on the reverse with an oval wet stamp with, in highlight, CONTADURIA GENERAL / PROVINCIA DE ENTRE RIOS and in the inner oval, 1880. It is possible that this stamp was used to cancel the titles returned to the province's counters, but this remains to be clarified.
